

Arthur M. & Berdena King Eagle Scout Contest

Open to all Eagle Scouts who are currently registered in an active unit and have not reached their 19th birthday during the year of application.

Note: The application year is the calendar year, 01 Jan. to 31 Dec.

The year that Eagle was awarded is not restricted.

College plans do not need to be completed in order to receive the cash scholarship.

The competition is conducted in three phases, local (Chapter), State (Society), and National.

Three cash awards are given at the National level:

First Place winner - **\$10,000.00**

Runner-up - **\$6,000.00**

2nd runner-up - **\$4,000.00**

You may apply more than one year if you meet the age requirements but no more than \$10,000.00 total may be granted to any one Eagle Scout.

Kentucky State winners receive a Trophy and \$500; 2nd place receives \$200; and 3rd place \$100. Price amounts may vary by State.

Local Louisville chapter winners receive a Certificate and \$200. Prize amounts may vary by Chapter.

Entrants need to complete only one application -- the one for the chapter competition.

Chapter winners are automatically submitted for the state competition. In turn, state winners are automatically submitted for the national competition.

The application consists of:

1. The two page application form.
2. The Four Generation ancestor chart.
3. The 500 word Patriotic Theme.

Prizes and recognitions may also be awarded at the SAR Chapter and State levels.

Note: Applications are accepted during a calendar year for Scholarships to be awarded in the Spring of the following year. In this case, Spring 2016.

Applications are due December 31, 2016 (subject to change).

For the Louisville, Kentucky area, the competition is entered through the Louisville-Thruston Chapter, Kentucky Society, Sons of the American Revolution.
